



1 2 BASIC RULES OF FOOTGOLF

1. Review the scorecard and wait for your turn.
2. Make sure your kick will not interfere with other players.
3. Your ball must be easy to identify.
4. Kick off your ball from behind the tee markers.
5. The player farthest from the hole is the first to kick the ball.
6. The ball must be played in a single movement. You are not allowed to push the ball with the top or bottom of your foot. Your foot should be set separate from the ball, clearly behind, before each kick.
7. Wait to play until the ball has completely come to rest. (It is not legal to stop the ball from rolling with the wind).
8. Out of bounds markers are annotated with white stakes.
9. Place the ball within 2 steps from where the ball crossed between the white stakes receiving a one stroke penalty.
10. Play the ball from where it lies: You are not allowed to move the ball or remove jammed objects. Exception: You may mark the spot and lift the ball when it may obstruct the other player's kick or ball in any way.
11. The order of play is established based on the score of the previous hole. The player with the best score will kick off first on the next hole followed by the second, etc.
12. If the ball lands in a water hazard, retrieve or replace it within 2 steps from the closest land point from where the ball entered the hazard (annotated by red line or red stake), receiving a one stroke penalty or you can place the ball at the position of the previous kick and receive one stroke penalty.

Local FootGolf Rules

- Play from the Orange tee markers to the Orange flags!
- Do not walk on golf greens or kick ball from golf greens. Drop to side at no penalty.
- Wear appropriate clothing. Since we play on a golf course, golf apparel is highly recommended. Soccer cleats are not allowed at anytime.
- Please make sure to keep up with the group in front of you.
- No personal or outside food or beverage is allowed.
- Please respect golfers and course personnel, and please rake bunkers once you exit.
- SAFETY begins with you!
 - Please monitor children at all times. Golf balls can hurt, or even cause serious damage if you are struck by one. If you hear someone yell "FORE", that means that a golf ball is headed in your direction. Quickly turn your back to the voice, and protect your head.
 - Be extremely careful retrieving your soccer ball if played into an adjoining hole, and if necessary, wait for golfers to clear the line of play.
 - Disney's Oak Trail Golf Course is host to an abundance of native wildlife; some of which may be dangerous if you get too close. Be extra careful around all water hazards as well as in the wooded areas. Do not feed wildlife at any time, for their best interest, and to ensure your safety.
- Be sure to stay hydrated, wear sunscreen, and possibly apply bug repellent, depending upon the time of day.
- Water and ice stations are located at the Starter stand, and after hole #6.
