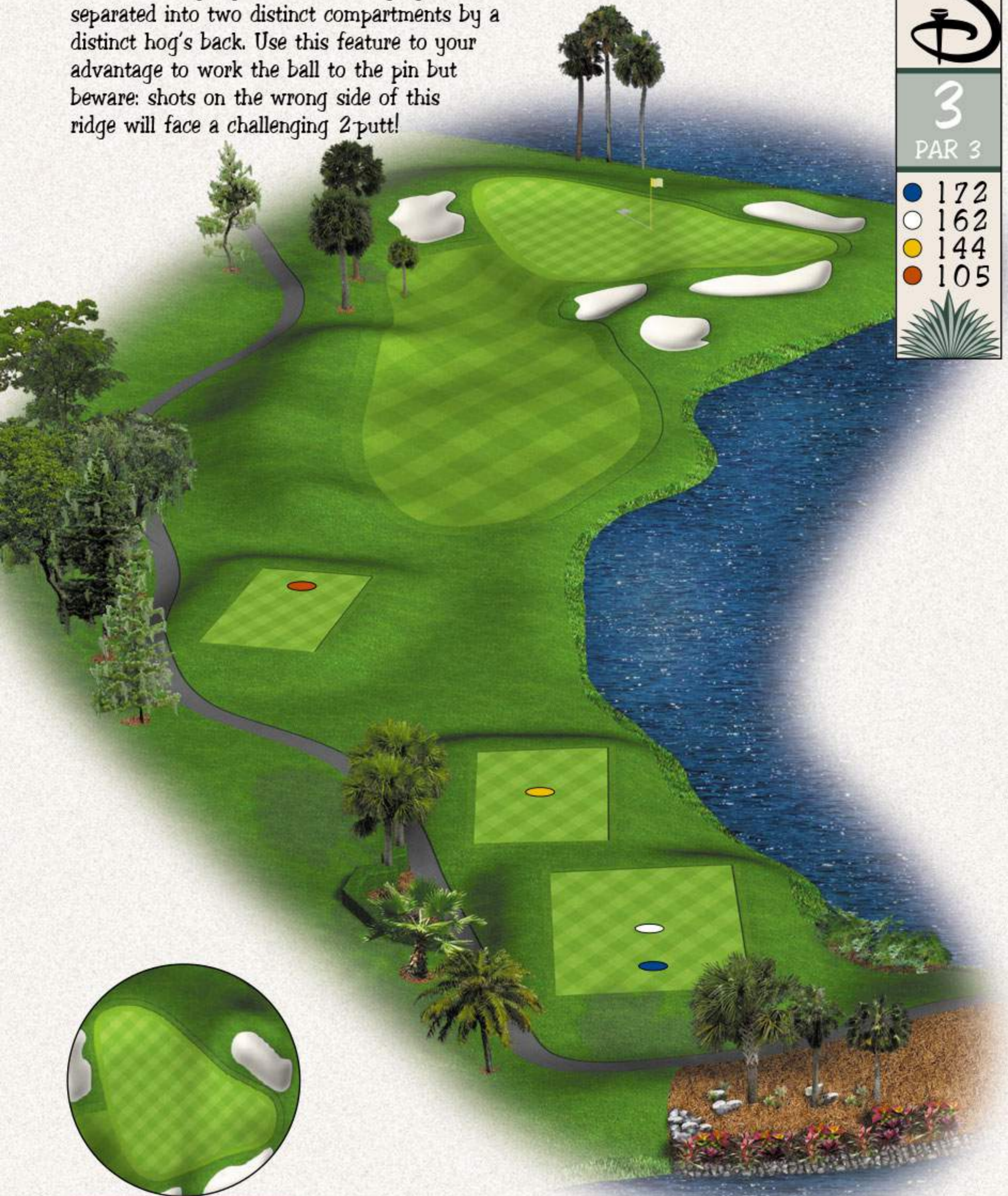


A mediumlength par 3 with a large green that is separated into two distinct compartments by a distinct hog's back. Use this feature to your advantage to work the ball to the pin but beware: shots on the wrong side of this ridge will face a challenging 2 putt!

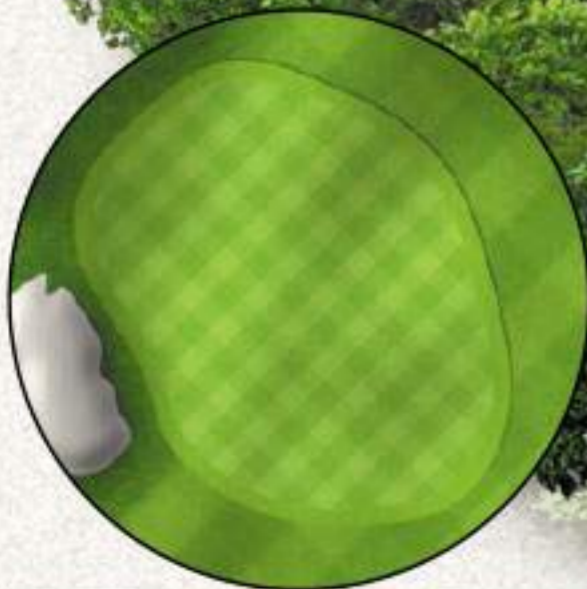
The longest par 3 on the Palm, with one of the largest greens, is protected toward the front with a small trap some 10 yards short of the green that will grab any shots along the ground that miss their mark.

Back left flags are protected by bunkering but accessible from the right by way of a gentle helping slope.

Don't let the distance fool you; this short par 3 requires an exacting short iron to avoid the array of bunkers that surround this small, cleverly contoured green. Short pins will be the most difficult to access.
